Exposition Tabernacle, new statues of Mary & Joseph, Kneeler and Altar table, Sanctuary Rug, and two new Memorial Candle Stands.



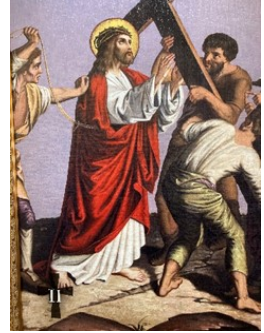

- ◆ New Screen and Kneeler for Confessional built by Sauder—(Matching our existing furniture)
- ◆ New lighting for north walkways and all cloister walkways
- ◆ New Outdoor Fans in Porch/Portico

- ◆ New Stained-glass windows for Church and Chapel—expected late fall of 2022

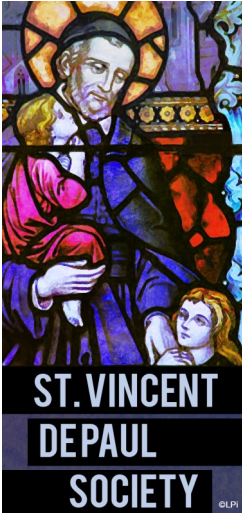
In General:

Who are we and what do we do?.

We are a Society of over 800,000 Conferences around the world with 81 Conferences in the Phoenix Diocese. Blessed Frederic Ozanam, who founded St. Vincent de Paul in 1833 in Paris, wanted us to do what Christ did which is go to the poor. Our mission is to help those in need and see Christ in each one of them. All people are children of God. We do not judge or discriminate in any way.

Our tenants are:

Feed—Four thousand (4,000) meals are served every day at SVdP Downtown. Locally we help clients with food gift cards and let them know of other local resources such as St. Mary’s Food Bank and Matthew’s Crossing both located in Chandler.

Clothe—Donations made to our Thrift Stores help those in need by allowing them to purchase items at reduced cost. We shop for the homeless so that they can have clothes available at SVdP Downtown.

House—Homeless Prevention—We help with rental assistance and utilities such as gas, electric and water. Our trained Vincentians meet with clients to review all needs not just rent and utilities. We provide them with other resources that may be able to help such as AZCEND in Chandler. We want to help families be sustainable.

Heal—Our uninsured clients can call the Medical Clinic to get an appointment. This can be for preventive or specialty care. Our Dental Clinic has a monthly lottery for uninsured clients to enter.
